



ABOUT ASSAM

Assam is a state in northeast India, situated south of the eastern Himalayas along the Brahmaputra and Barak River valleys. The state is bordered by Bhutan and Arunachal Pradesh to the north; Nagaland and Manipur to the east; Meghalaya, Tripura, Mizoram and Bangladesh to the south; and West Bengal to the west.

Assam is known for Assam tea and Assam silk. The state was the first in Asia, where oil was drilled. Assam has conserved the one-horned Indian rhinoceros from near extinction, along with the wild water buffalo, pygmy hog, tiger and various species of Asiatic birds, and provides one of the last wild habitats for the Asian elephant. The Assamese economy is aided by wildlife tourism to Kaziranga National Park and Manas National Park, which are World Heritage Sites. Assam receives more rainfall than most parts of India; this rain feeds the Brahmaputra River, whose tributaries and oxbow lakes provide the region with a hydro-geomorphic environment.

Assam is one of the richest biodiversity zones in the world and consists of tropical rainforests, deciduous forests, riverine grasslands, bamboo orchards and numerous wetland ecosystems.

Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Department, Assam

The economy of Assam is agriculture based wherein 70 percent of the population is engaged in agriculture as a primary occupation and Livestock rearing is a predominant subsystem. Animal Husbandry is potentially one of the most important sectors of rapid socio-economic development of the state. Assam has few recognized indigenous livestock breeds of its own which includes Lakhimi (Cattle), Doom (Pig), Assam Hill Goat (Goat), Pati (Duck), Daichingir and Miri (Poultry). And a new Poultry breed named KAMRUPA developed by AAU.

Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Department (AHVD), has a wide spread service provider network of 325 Dispensaries, 134 Block Veterinary Dispensaries, 767 Veterinary sub centers throughout the state to cater the need of Livestock farmers of the entire state. Besides these the department has an A graded Frozen semen station of Barapeta, 16 Regional Frozen semen distribution banks for the state cattle upgradation programme. It also has a North East Regional Disease Diagnostic Laboratory(NERDOL) and an Institution of Veterinary Biologicals for production of Animal vaccines of Guwahati and 19 Regional Disease diagnostic labs spread throughout the state. The state has a Farmer's Training center RILEM at Rani and an Officer's Training Institute of Khanapara for capacity building of farmers and departmental officers respectively.

The department is undergoing a strategic shift in its functioning and service delivery.

National Livestock & Poultry Show, Assam - 2019

The Animal Husbandry Sector in the region is growing in a very slow pace and not at par the national growth. Though the region have huge livestock population the production and productivity is very low. AHVD is committed to the Hon'ble Chief Ministers vision of doubling the farmer's income through climate resilient and sustainable farming systems. It feels the present day need to improve the Livestock scenario of the state to inspire confidence among different players of the commercial livestock ventures.
