Objective	To produce quality ducklings of Khaki Campbell/ Indian Runner /Chara Chambeli/ White Pekin for farmers to rear in backyard system in order to enhance the egg production and to support household subsidiary income as well as nutritional requirement. To generate opportunities of self-employment among the educated unemployed youths, particularly for rural areas of the state by ensuring technical guidance in scientific duck management, to generate income, and their products could provide nutritional security to the rural pool. To enable doubling of farmers income by providing an alternative livelihood for farmers as one sources of their income. To increase duck population in the locality.
